Campers develop or deepen a love of figuring things out when they're building something that responds to their ideas. **Rocks and Robots** is a long-running Ann Arbor summer camp where kids build real robots, test ideas, revise them, and try again. Campers are immersed in an environment where trying, adjusting, and trying again is expected and supported—often shaped by seeing what others attempt and by guidance from older/returning campers who once stood in their shoes. They program autonomous robots, see how design choices affect behavior, and come to treat wins and losses as useful information. Twice a week, campers become climbers at Planet Rock. 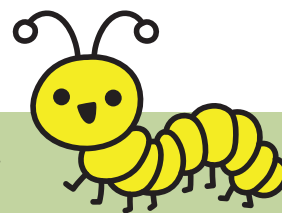
